



My Future in Agriculture Video Contest – Rules and Guidelines

Rules and Guidelines

1. Entrants will submit a video answering 3 questions "What does your future career in agriculture look like?" "How will you get there?" "Why are you passionate about a career in agriculture?"
2. The videos must be a minimum of 30 seconds long, maximum 90 seconds.
3. Videos must be uploaded to the appropriate DropBox link provided in contest promotions
4. Submissions will not be accepted after February 2nd, 2018.
5. Must be a legal resident of the Canada, aged 14-18 to participate in the contest.
6. All entries must include a digital video and a completed application form
7. Multiple entries are not allowed.
8. If the winner is unable to accept the prize, the prize will be forfeited in its entirety.
9. No substitution of prize is offered, no transfer of prize to a third party is permitted.
10. Prizes will be awarded only upon winner verification and approval by Agriculture in the Classroom Canada. The winner will be notified by email within 10 days after winning. The winner or selected entrant will then have 10 days to respond with their information. If the winner or selected entrant is unable to be contacted within 10 days after being selected or is ineligible, the prize will be forfeited.
11. Agriculture in the Classroom Canada retains the right to disqualify any contestant if the rules are not followed.
12. Any information collected by registering to enter the contest shall be used only in a manner consistent with these Contest Rules.
13. If the contest is not able to run as planned, without limitation, Agriculture in the Classroom Canada reserves the right to cancel, terminate, or modify the contest at their discretion.
14. All information presented in the video must be cited, giving credit to the original source. Plagiarism of any kind will result in disqualification.
15. There is no entry fee.
16. Entries may be submitted through the DropBox link starting on October 2, 2017. The deadline for submissions is 5:00 pm (Eastern time) on February 2, 2018. Winners will be announced no later than March 2, 2018.
17. No professional assistance is allowed. Adults may assist with production but are limited to verbal guidance only.
18. All portions of the online entry form must be completed when you upload your video for it to be eligible.
19. IF CHOSEN AS A FINALIST you must submit a signed/completed **Parent Permission Form**. Finalist videos CANNOT be awarded a prize unless the necessary forms are received. Forms can be scanned/emailed to: bparker@aitc-canada.ca
20. Content must comply with all local and national laws of Canada. Content must not 1) promote illegal behavior; 2) support racial, religious, sexual or other invidious prejudice; 3) advocate sexual or violent exploitation; 4) violate rights established by law or agreement; 5) invade the privacy of any person; or 6) be otherwise inappropriate as determined by Agriculture in the Classroom Canada in its sole and conclusive determination.
21. The judges' decision is final. Decisions will be made based on the Agriculture in the Classroom Judging Criteria.



Legal Guidelines:

- Students should keep at least one copy of their video. Agriculture in the Classroom Canada is not responsible for any films that are lost, damaged, or that do not upload properly.
- Ownership of the underlying intellectual property of the project remains with the entrant, with the following exceptions:
 - Entrants grant Agriculture in the Classroom Canada the right to use their names, photographs, statements, quotes, testimonials, and video submissions for advertising, publicity, and promotional purposes without notification or further compensation.
 - Entrants also grant Agriculture in the Classroom Canada the right to use, reproduce, reprint, distribute, perform, and/or display the entrant's project video without further compensation or notification to the entrant.
 - Agriculture in the Classroom Canada maintains the right to reproduce, reprint, distribute, perform, display, or exhibit the project for advertising, publicity, and promotional purposes on their website, at conferences, or at any other venues.
- By accepting the prizes, winners agree to hold Agriculture in the Classroom Canada and all Agriculture in the Classroom Canada Population Connection employees harmless against any and all claims and liability arising out of use of such prizes. Winner assumes all liability for any injury or damage caused from participation in the contest or use/redemption of any prize.
- Entrants agree to be bound by the official contest rules and decisions of the judges.
